

**The Feast of Mary, Mother of God (Thursday, January 1) is A HOLY DAY OF OBLIGATION** in this year of 2026. Mass will be celebrated on New Year's Eve (Wednesday December 31) at **4:15PM and at 8AM and 10AM** on Thursday, January 1, 2026. There is no better way to begin 2026 than by uniting with our Blessed Mother in prayers of peace, and joining in her Son's Eucharist. Join in the Mass on New Year's Day!

**Polish Christmas Carols** - All Saints Parish in Boswell will host their annual singing of Polish Christmas carols (known as Koledy or Pastoralki) on Sunday, Jan., 4th, 2026 at 2PM at their Church (325 Quemahoning Street, Boswell). The carols will be sung by the parish Polish choir. Following the singing of the hymns there will be benediction of the Blessed Sacrament and refreshments. While the singing of koledy was once a very common practice in the Polish-American community, in recent times church choirs that continue the tradition of singing koledy have become increasingly rare. These hymns help to capture some of the finest sentiments, values, and emotions of the Polish religious, national, and artistic heritage. 
