INFANT BAPTISM - Please contact the parish office 1 or 2 months before your desired date to schedule the Baptism of your child. First-time parents must complete a Baptism preparation class. The classes are usually held on the first and/or third Thursday of the month at 6:30 pm. The classes are scheduled only when needed. Please call Deacon Mark to schedule your attendance (814)-233-9285.

If the parents are not registered members of St. Peter's Church (call the parish office to confirm registration), they must submit a letter granting permission to baptize from their home parish.

Parents should choose one or two Catholic godparents (one male and one female) who must obtain a letter of suitability from their home parish. Catholic godparents must have received the Sacrament of Confirmation and be in good standing in their home parish. If only one Catholic godparent is chosen, the second Christian witness may be a baptized member of another Christian denomination and provide a letter from their pastor that verifies their Baptism and membership. Catholic Godparent and Christian witness should be one male and one female.

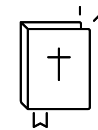

St. Thomas More - Father, Patron Saint of Politicians/Leaders.

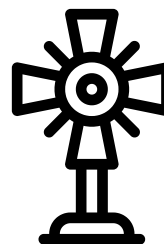
